RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Randy Ikerman for Alpha Mike

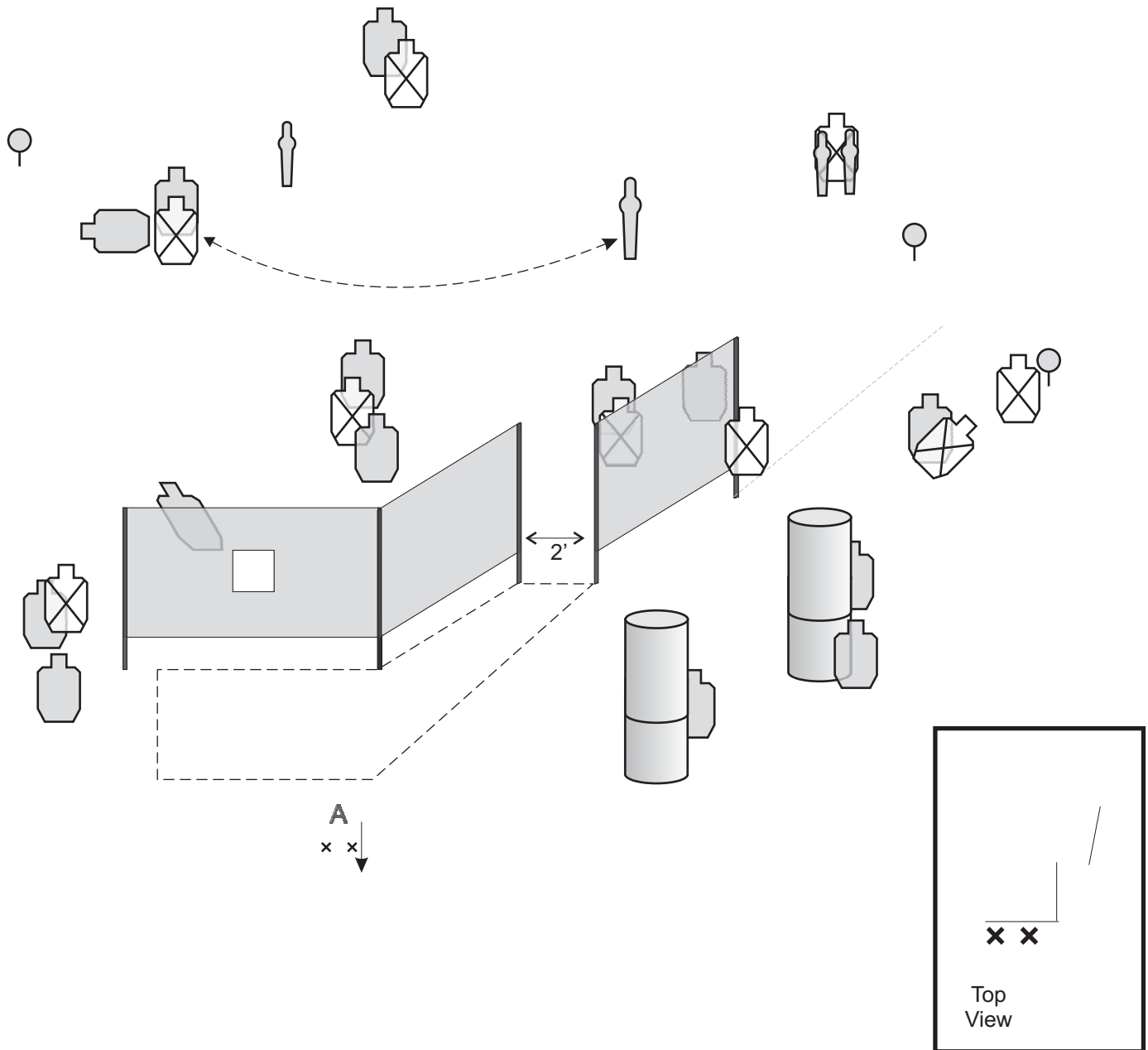
START POSITION: Standing in Box A, toes on X's inside box, shoulders squarely facing up range, with gun un-loaded in holster, all mags on belt, and hands fully above shoulders.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal turn, draw, load, and engage ALL targets as they become visible from within box or fault lines. Walls are from ground to infinity.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 31 rounds, 165 points
TARGETS: 13 IPSC, 4 PP, 3 SP
SCORED HITS: Best per IPSC and PP
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10 (includes Wall Hits)
 No-shoot hit. -10
 Miss. -10
 Failure to Engage. -10



SETUP NOTES:

Poppers near berm should be backed by no-shoots in such a way that the main part of the steel is centered directly in the angle of fire from the walls.

RO NOTES:

Warn shooter of dangerous 180 possibility when retreating around forward wall.
