

# Around or Under?

**RULES:** Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition

**COURSE DESIGNER:** Bob Woolley

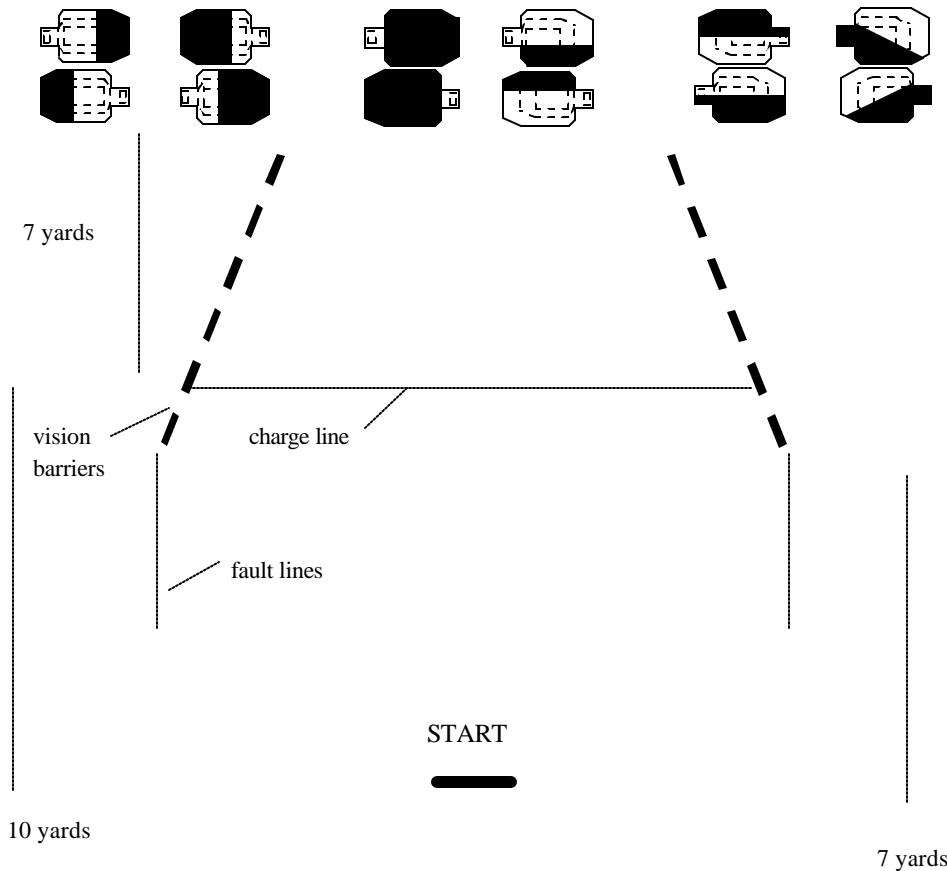
**START POSITION:** Facing directly downrange, toes of both feet touching start line; both hands on top of head.

## STAGE PROCEDURE

At signal, draw and engage targets as they become visible. Vision barriers extend infinitely upward, but do not extend downward to ground.

## SCORING

**SCORING:** Comstock, 24 rounds, 120 points  
**TARGETS:** 12 IPSC  
**SCORED HITS:** Best 2 per IPSC  
**START-STOP:** Audible - Last shot  
**PENALTIES:** Procedural. -10  
 No-shoot hit. -10  
 Miss. -10



**SETUP NOTES:** Targets are stacked in pairs. Target pairs will need to be set low enough that the tops of every target can be seen from a single prone position near the center of the charge line, looking underneath the vision barriers. Targets should be set as deeply into the shooting bay as possible, so that no shots fired from a prone position will escape the berm, and none fired from a standing position will skip across the bay's floor.

**RO NOTES:** Remember that fault lines extend infinitely uprange.
