Baby Bullet

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Harold Ham

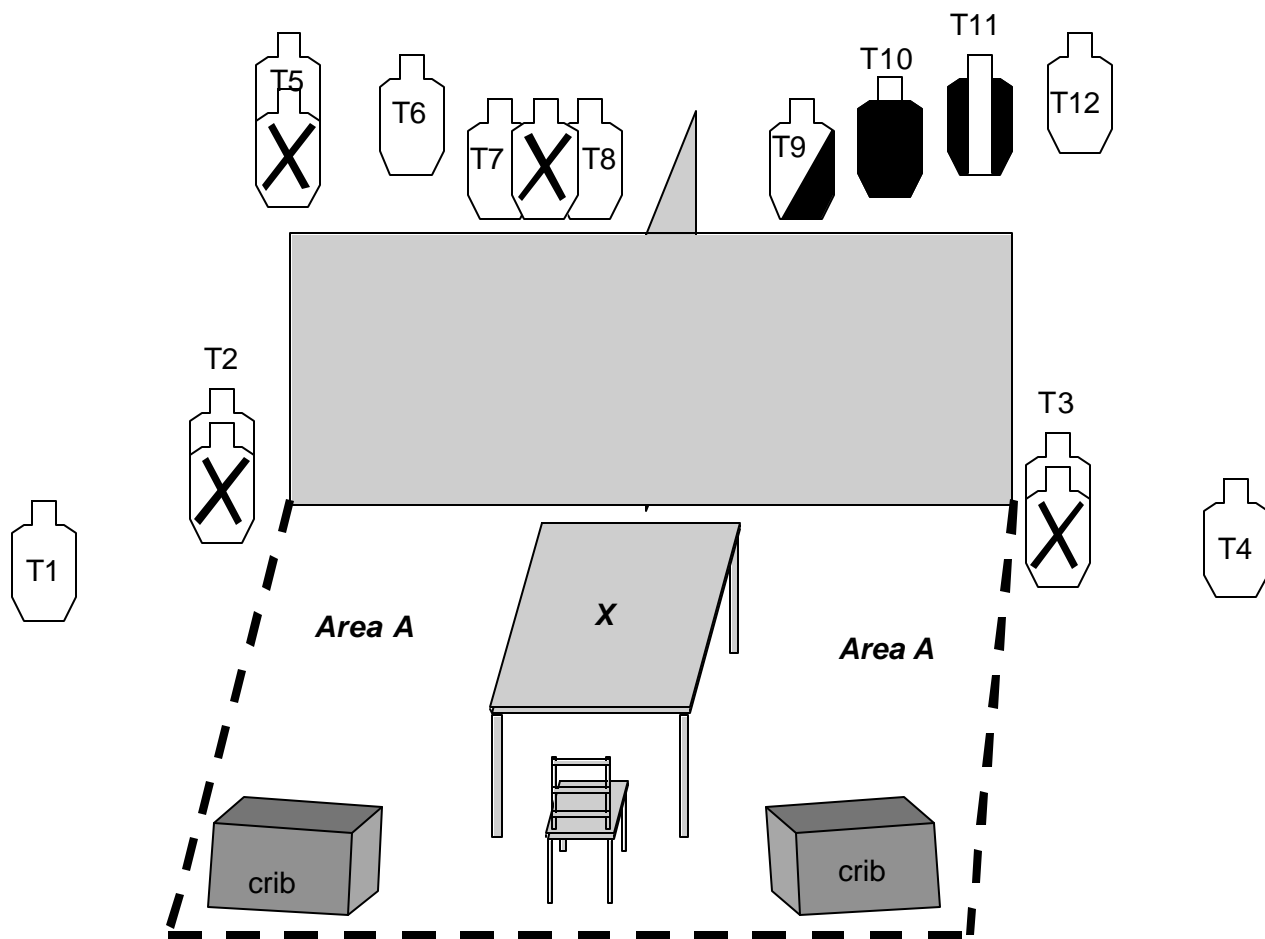
START POSITION: Seated in chair, back against chair, cradling Baby Bullet (as defined by RO) in weak arm, strong hand holding baby bottle with nipple to Baby Bullet's lips. Loaded gun on table on the X mark. Spare ammo carried on belt.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, place Baby Bullet in crib, then retrieve gun from table and from Area A only, engage targets as they become visible.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 24 rounds, 120 points
TARGETS: 12 IPSC
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
No-shoot hit. -10
Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES:

RO NOTES: one procedural penalty will be assessed for each shot fired with Baby Bullet anywhere other than the crib
