

# From Across The Table

**RULES:** Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition      **COURSE DESIGNER:** Bill Martin A39796

**START POSITION:** Seated in chair with back against the back of the chair. Gun is unloaded, slide forward, hammer down and laying flat in briefcase along with all required ammo. The briefcase lid is closed.

## STAGE PROCEDURE

On the signal, retrieve weapon from within briefcase, load as required and engage all targets, as they become visible from Box A. If a reload is required, the ammo/loaded magazine must have been in the briefcase before the shooting started.

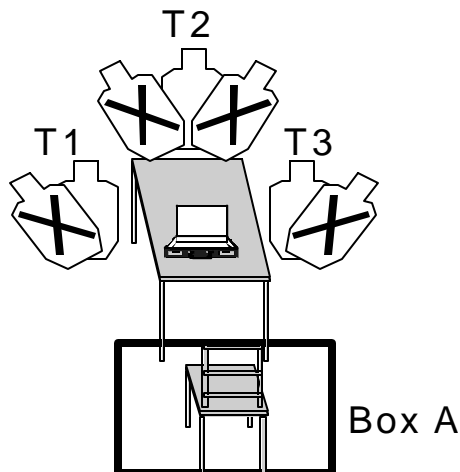
## SCORING

**SCORING:** Virginia count, 8 rounds, 40 points  
**TARGETS:** 3 IPSC, 2 USP  
**SCORED HITS:** Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A  
**START-STOP:** Audible - Last shot  
**PENALTIES:** Procedural. -10  
No-shoot hit. -10  
Extra shot. -10  
Extra hit. -10  
Miss. -10

**SETUP NOTES:** The base of T1 and T3 are at ground level. T2's base is level with the tabletop. Keep all steel at least 11 yards from the shooter. The briefcase should be screwed to the table. The chair and the shooting box should be nailed down.

**RO NOTES:** Engaging steel closer than ten yards is a match DQ. One procedural penalty per shot fired, if a reload is made with ammo/ magazine not contained within brief case at the start of the stage.
