

I Pity the Fool!

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition

COURSE DESIGNER: Bob Woolley

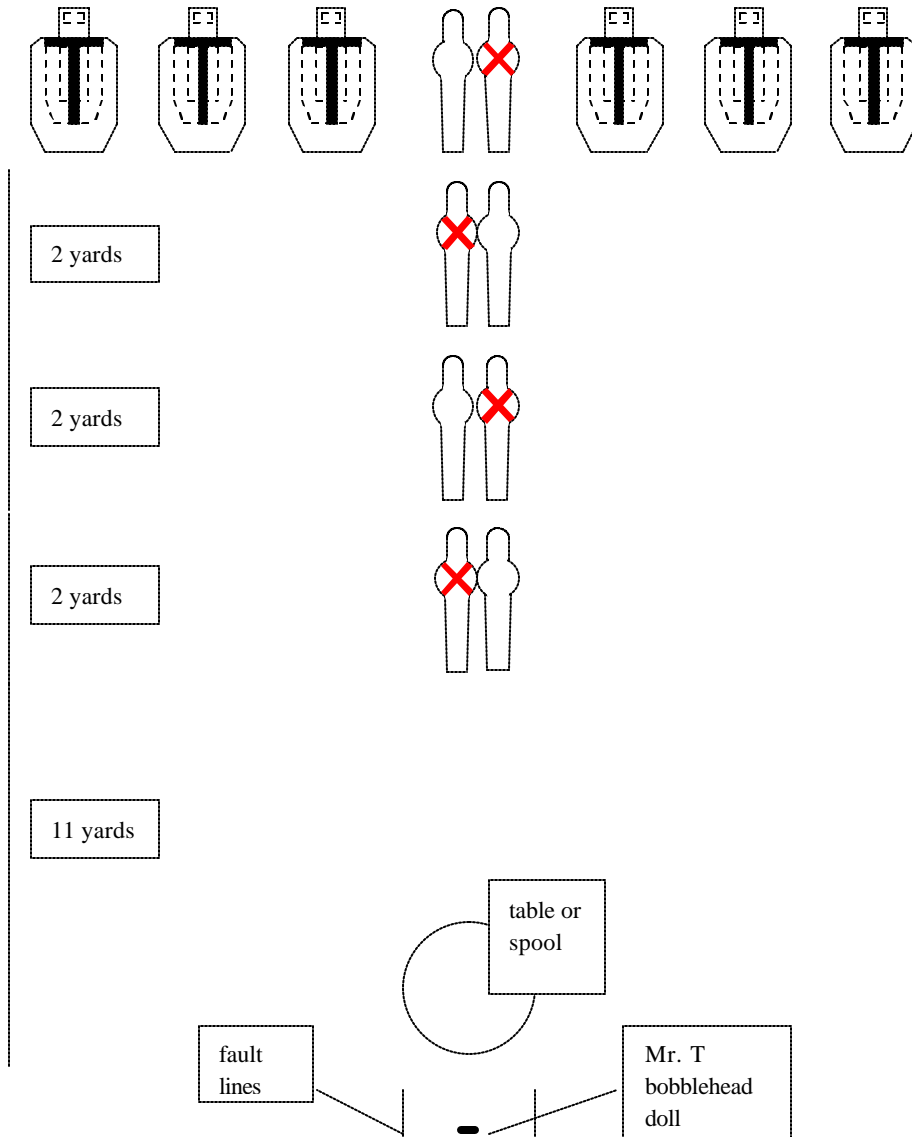
START POSITION: Both hands flat on table, index fingers touching doll, shooter's head bobbing along with Mr. T.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On start signal, engage targets. Steel may only be engaged from behind the table, within the fault lines. "T" zones on targets are hard cover.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 22 rounds, 110 points
TARGETS: 6 IPSC, 4 PP
SCORED HITS: Best 3 per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
 No-shoot hit. -10
 Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: "T"-shaped hard cover is 2" (or 5 cm) wide. Steel penalty targets should be set not to fall when hit. Set paper targets a yard or so behind the last pair of steel targets to reduce splatter. Paper targets can be any convenient distance apart. Put a charge line a yard or two in front of the paper targets to prevent point-blank shooting at them.
