

Peekaboo Swinger

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition

COURSE DESIGNER: Bob Woolley

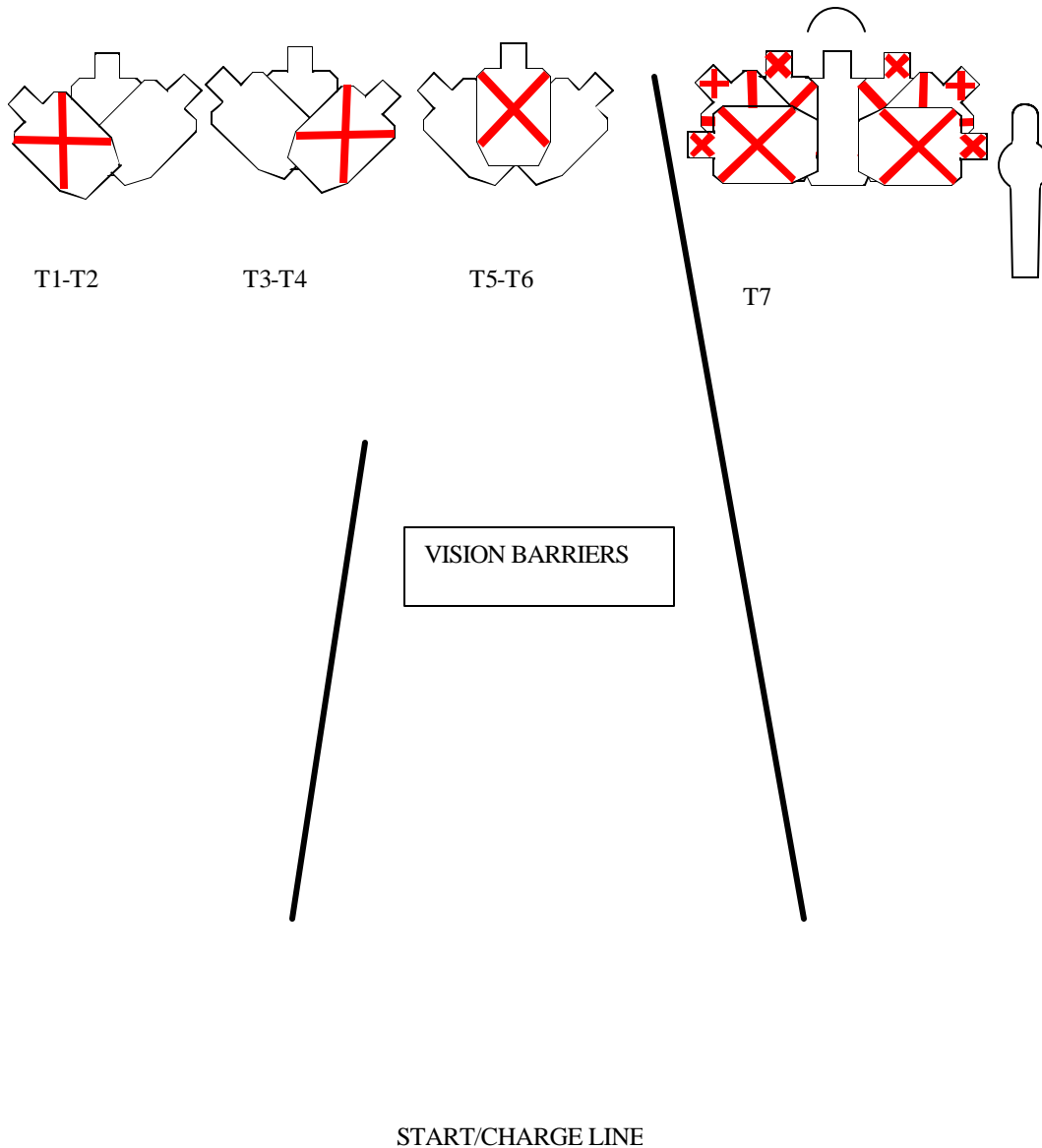
START POSITION: Anywhere behind start/charge line, facing directly uprange, hands covering face (as if playing Peekaboo with a child).

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, turn, draw, and engage targets as they become visible. T7 is a swinging target activated by popper, and remains visible at rest. Steel may only be engaged from the start/charge line (at least one foot touching line, or both feet behind it). The charge line restricts forward movement only with respect to the steel target.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 22 rounds, 110 points
TARGETS: 7 IPSC, 1 PP
SCORED HITS: Best 3 per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
 No-shoot hit. -10
 Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Drawing is not to scale. T1-T2 should be visible only from left of the left vision

RO NOTES: Because we have no steel penalty targets available, there will scoring problems with shots penetrating a

barrier. There should be an area on the far left side of the bay from which all of T1-T6 are visible.

no-shoot before hitting T7. Have the assistant RO watch for where shots are hitting. During scoring, check for “grease marks” and alignment of bullet holes to determine whether an apparent hit on T7 actually scores or not.
