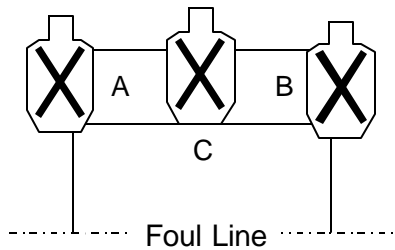
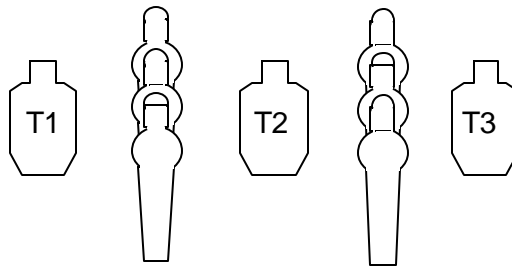
START POSITION: Standing toes at foul line, Directly in front of middle No-Shoot, hands naturally at sides.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On start signal, draw and engage T1, PP1, T2, PP2 and T3 ONLY thru **Port A-B or C**, make a mandatory reload and engage T1, PP3, T2, PP4 and T3 ONLY thru **Port A-B or C**, make a mandatory reload and engage T1, PP5, T2, PP6 and T3 ONLY thru **Port A-B or C** (see **RO notes**)

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 24 rounds, 120 points
TARGETS: 3 IPSC, 6 Pepper Poppers
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: 2' between targets and poppers. Line poppers up directly behind each other so only the front most popper is visible. Ports can be made with target stakes and duct tape. Staple No-Shoots as shown.

RO NOTES: Targets may be engaged from left or right thru port of **shooters choice**. Each port may be used **one time only** to engage targets.
