

# T- Shot 3-Shot

**RULES:** Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition

**COURSE DESIGNER:** Bob Woolley

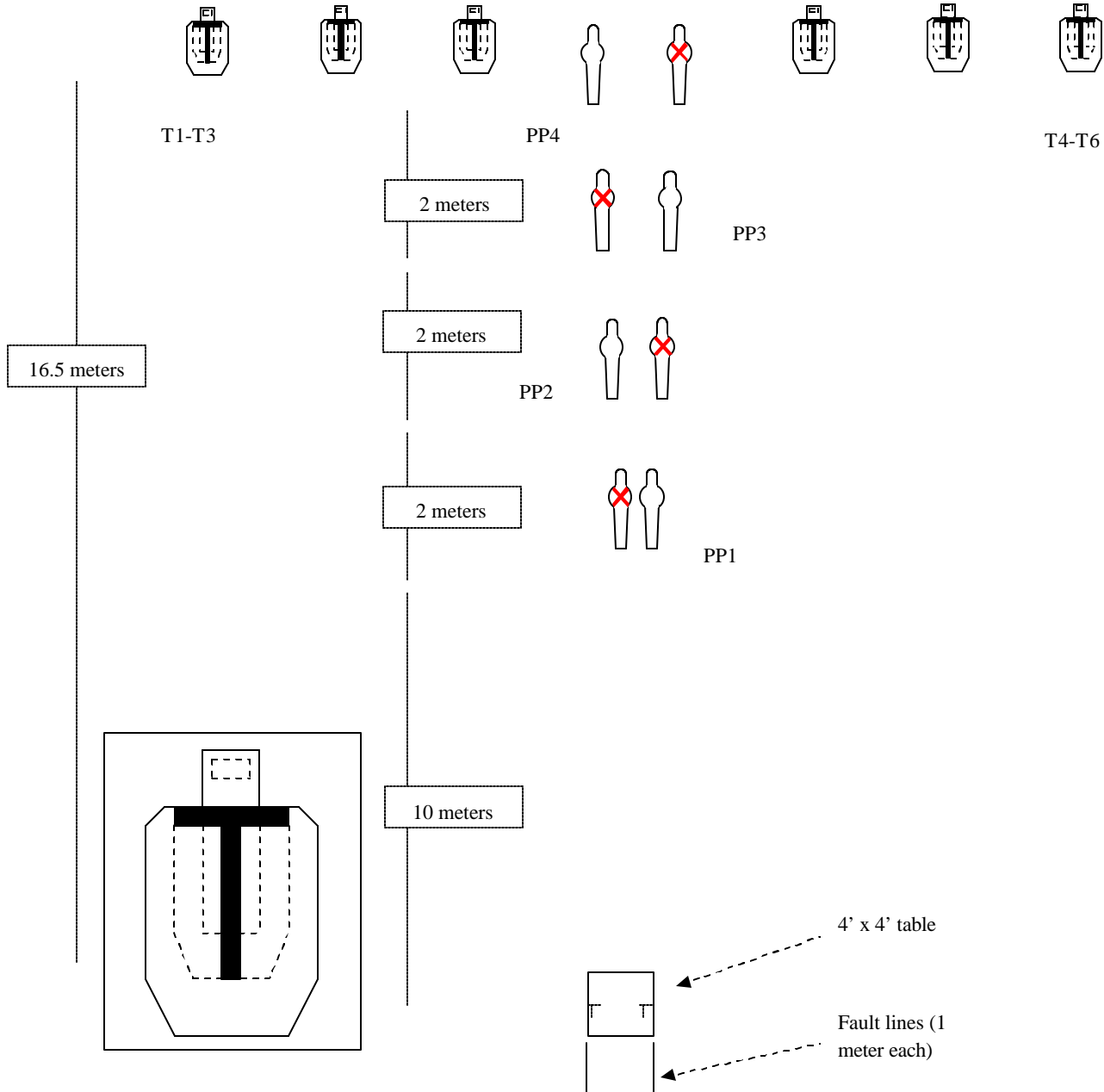
**START POSITION:** Both palms flat on table covering "T" marks.

### STAGE PROCEDURE

On start signal, engage targets. Steel may be engaged only from behind the table, within the fault lines. "T" zones on targets are hard cover.

### SCORING

**SCORING:** Comstock, 22 rounds, 110 points  
**TARGETS:** 6 IPSC, 4 PP  
**SCORED HITS:** Best 3 per IPSC, steel down = 1A  
**START-STOP:** Audible - Last shot  
**PENALTIES:** Procedural. -10; No-shoot hit. -10; Miss. -10



**SETUP NOTES:** "T"-shaped hard cover is 2" (or 5 cm) wide, as shown on inset above. Steel penalty targets should be set not to fall when hit. "T" marks are at midway point of each side edge of table. T1-T3 and T4-T6 are set 1 meter apart, edge to edge. Inside edges of T3 and T4 are 1.5 meters from outside edge of base of PP4 and its paired penalty popper. Inside edge of base of PP1 to inside edge of

base of its paired penalty popper is 0.25 meters, centered on longitudinal central axis of setup. Similarly, 0.5 meters between PP2 and its pair; 0.75 meters for PP3; 1.0 meter for PP4. From central axis line to outside edge of T1 and T6 should be 5.5 meters on each side.
